Contest Rules

Please read these notes carefully **before** the contest begins. The contest will be conducted according to FAI-Rules Class F3B, valid for 2012. For safety and organisational reasons the following items have been added or amended respectively: (Notes in brackets refer to the appropriate clauses of the FAI-Rules mentioned above).

1. Preparation Time

The preparation time of 5 minutes will officially be announced only to the first group of competitors of each task. All following competitors will only be called for preparation in due time.

2. Flight Area

The distance flights can be carried out either side of the safety plane. After the distance-and speed flight, the model must land in the area defined by the contest director. During the speed task only the pilot and his helpers are allowed to stay within the flight area. There is an airspace

restriction which will be announced in detail during the briefing.

3. Position of Winches and Pulleys

Positions of winches and pulleys are marked by number plates on each line. Winches and pulleys have to be placed on the same number at the respective line. The winch places are determined by draw by the organizer.

4. Task C Speed

Counting from the release of the working time, this task must be completed within **4 minutes**, including the towing time [5.3.2.5.a)]. The task will be carried out in a seamless manner. This means, the working time starts automatically when the previous pilot leaves the course.

5. Penalties

See the "FAI-Rules Class F3B, valid for 2012"

The IRKS Field (Space Coast Aeromodeling Park) is located on the south side of the Central Disposal Facility at: 1050 Adamson Road, Cocoa, FL 32926 which is located on the north side of SR524. Take I-95 to Exit 202. Go west 1.2 miles and turn Right on Adamson Road. Go 2.2 miles and turn Left into the Central Disposal Facility. Go 0.4 miles and turn left. Follow the road around to the south side (0.8 miles) and enter the field. GPS coordinates are N28d23m27s x W80d50m12s.
